## ENGIMA 2023

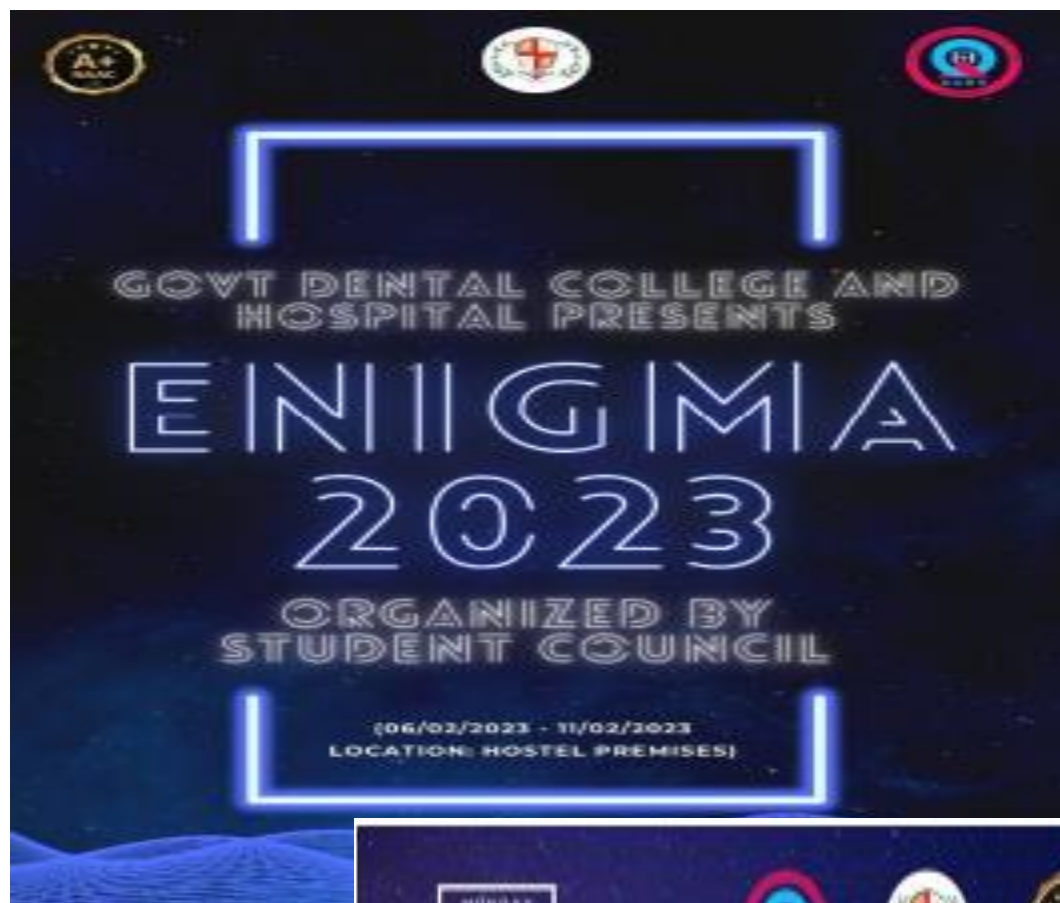
The ENGIMA FEST of GDCH AHMEDABAD was held from 6 th February 2023 to 11 th February 2023 organized by Student Council.

### **CULINARY FEST 2023**

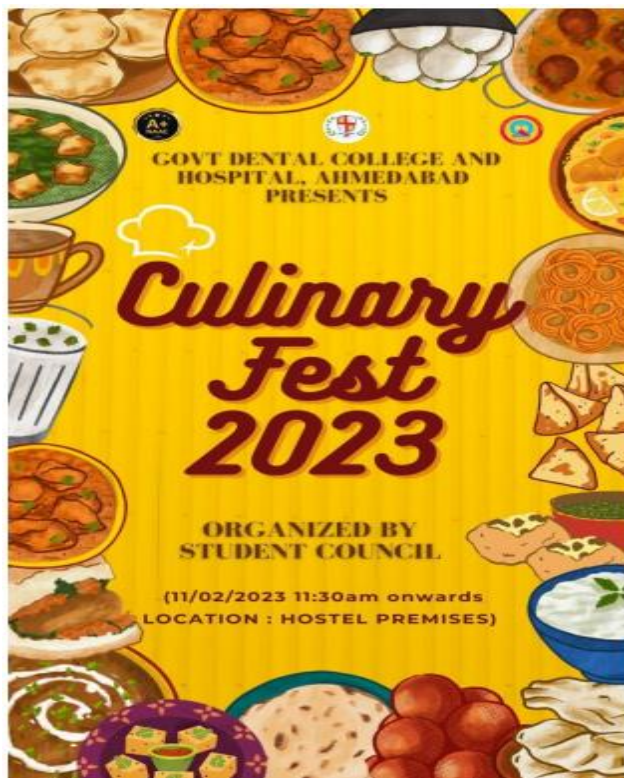

12. Two stalls were organized by PG students on which Bhel and Khaman were sold.



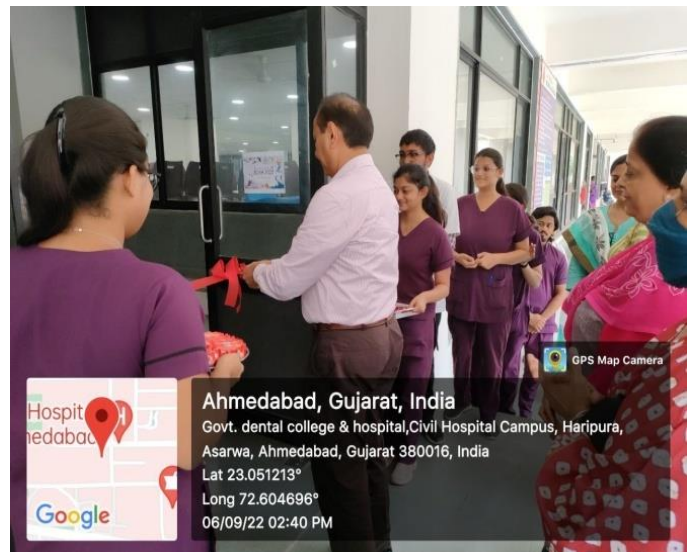
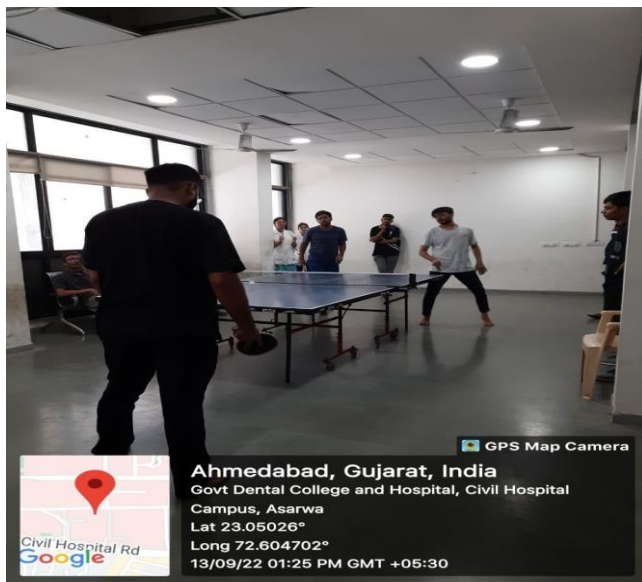

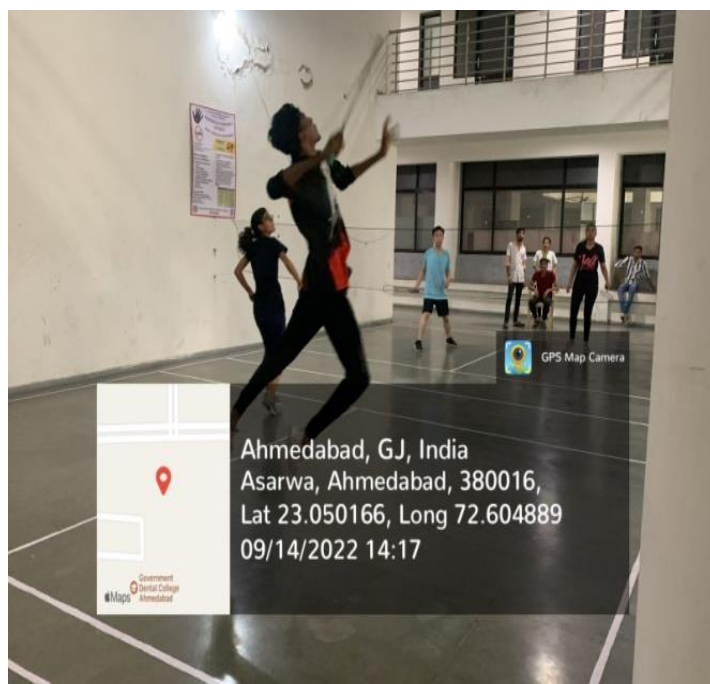
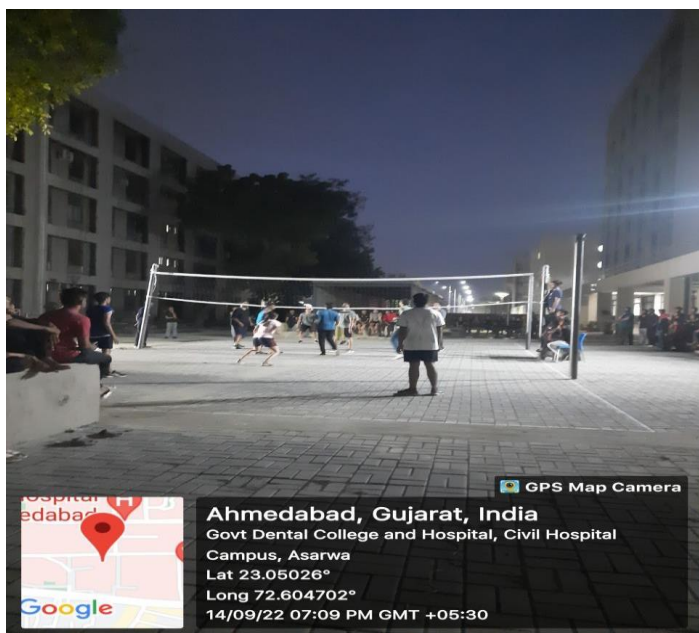




## JOSH 2022
